

**INVENTORY WAIVER**

Section 31.133 of the PUC rule states that the carrier must complete a detailed inventory listing all items to be moved and their condition. All items must be given an identification number. The inventory must be completed before loading. The shipper should observe and verify the inventory, noting the condition of all items. The carrier must provide the shipper with a copy of the completed inventory before loading and it must be signed by the shipper and the carrier. Upon delivery, the shipper should verify that all items on the inventory were delivered and their condition. The shipper should note on the inventory any missing or damaged items. The shipper must retain their copy of the inventory until all disputes are settled.

The shipper may waive this requirement, in writing, for moves 40 miles or less. I, \_\_\_\_\_, waive the inventory requirement for this move.

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**ESTIMATE WAIVER**

Section 31.122 of the PUC rule states that the carrier must give the shipper a written estimate 48 hours prior to the move, unless the shipper agrees, in writing, to a shorter period. The estimate will approximate the amount he/she believes it will cost the shipper to move his/her household furnishings. The *actual* charges may be more or less than the estimate.
